The Power of Your Fundraising

100% of your Play4TheCure donations go directly to cancer research, but you might wonder, "what exactly does the money provide?"

\$25-\$100- Stains one tissue slide from a tumor biopsy to look for a predictive biomarker of cancer metastasis

\$100- Performs one biopsy to get tumor tissues from a patient for a variety of pathological tests and biological analyses

\$250- Buys one case of petri dishes for growing cancer cells – an essential first step to identify tumor markers or test treatment effectiveness of new drugs

\$500-\$750- Buys one antibody test to determine whether tumor cells have a specific marker for drug resistance

\$1,000- Carries out a comprehensive genomewide analysis in one tumor sample, for developing targeted and personalized cancer therapies

Getting Started Checklist

Select an Event Date(s) Select a date(s) for your event. Keep in mind that you don't have to wait until the day of your event to fundraise. Use these new tools, and start fundraising now.
Personalize your GoFundMe Charity Page Update your online fundraising page with your story and photos. The more personalized your page, the greater the response from your supporters.
Set Your Goal We suggest setting your goal to at least \$1,000. As donations are made online, your goal thermometer will automatically update. If you receive off-line donations (checks or cash) you can always manually enter them into GoFundMe Charity.
Make a Self-Donation Lead by example and make a self-donation to see that thermometer get off the ground! This will encourage others to help you reach your goal.
Get Social Share your GoFundMe Charity page on social media by copying and pasting your page link. Make sure all of your teammates also have this link to share, with hashtags #Play4TheCure and #NFCR. Online fundraising greatly increases donations.
Spark Fundraising Ideas Discuss with your teams different ideas for fundraising activities. These activities can take place before, during and even after your event, until you hit your goal.

Fundraising Ideas

Throughout the years, our Play4TheCure teams have come up with many fun and unique ways to fundraise. For some inspiration, review these great ideas or feel free to create your own.



Host a Tournament

Bring together other teams from nearby communities to participate in a tournament. Charge a registration fee that will go towards your goal.

Host a Clinic

Invite local youth athletes and teams to participate in a your sports clinic day. You can charge a registration fee or simply ask for donations.

Create a Silent Auction

At your event, offer memorabilia, apparel or items donated from local businesses that fans can bid on. The person with the highest bid takes home the prize.

Sell T-Shirts

Have team t-shirts made and sell them leading up to and during your game.

Hold a Pledge Drive

Host a game in which spectators are able to pledge in advance to donate for each point scored. Each supporter can choose what amount they would like to pledge.

Host a Restaurant Fundraiser

Many local restaurants have give-back nights that donate a portion of food sales to a charitable cause. Some popular restaurants that participate include Buffalo Wild Wings, California Pizza Kitchen, Chili's, Boston Market, Chipotle and Panera Bread.

Car Wash

Have your team roll up their sleeves and host a car wash day, with a fee donated to your team's goal.
